It's Time for PAR!

Stewardship is a reflection of gratitude, and not just about money. It's about the gifts you can bring to the congregation. That said, your regular contributions help the Church fulfill a big part of its mission. As part of our stewardship efforts, we have launched a campaign to encourage **everyone** to sign up to PAR.

Our goal is to have 100 PAR members by the end of the campaign!

Why PAR?

PAR is a convenient way for churches to ensure a regular giving program. If members are away for the summer or winter, PAR helps them keep their commitment without having to “catch up” on their giving. This provides stability to giving patterns so churches can plan and pay bills in a timely manner.

How much should I give?

Since PAR is a monthly program, you can start by multiplying your regular plate offering by 4.

What if I change my mind, or my circumstances?

You can suspend or stop contributions at any time. That way the program allows you to adjust your contributions to match your capacity for giving
