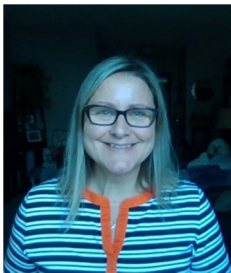

NEWS FROM THE REOPENING COMMITTEE

In keeping with the new provincial standards for indoor gatherings the Reopening Circle has decided to revise our Reopening Protocol to require proof of vaccination prior to attending ANY indoor gatherings including worship, at Kitchissippi United Church.

We are developing a form for recording “proof”, so that participants do not have to show their documents each time they register. Ensuring vaccination will make us more confident that everyone is as safe as possible and transmission is kept to a minimum.

Also, please dress warmly for worship in the Sanctuary as windows and doors are being left open to ensure adequate ventilation. Fans are not being used in the Sanctuary because they interfere with the live-streaming sound.
