First-ever Ottawa Eco Award given to Julianne Labreche



Ecology Ottawa has named Julianne Labreche the first winner of a Nature Champion Award, in its Eco Awards, this month. As a Master Gardener, Julianne planned and opened our rejuvenated Alcove Garden (see picture), working closely with Denise Bonomo at Kitchissippi, in June of 2022. That day was a marvellous intergenerational day of fun and education on pollinators, with a native plant sale, activities for kids and Indigenous storytelling. Julianne is an accomplished writer and public

speaker, authoring many articles on ecological and wildlife-friendly gardening, and speaking to groups across Ontario on similar subjects. The award citation read: “Julianne is a font of knowledge and an inspiration who leads by example.” Julianne and her husband, Barry Wilson, attend KUC.

Men’s Book Club welcomes local author- Barry Wilson

Barry Wilson spoke about his recent book to an expanded, mixed gathering of the Men’s Book Club on Tuesday, April 25. Sir Mackenzie Bowell: A Canadian Prime Minister Forgotten by History was a finalist for the 2022 Ottawa Book Awards. Barry told the story of researching the book, showed us some fascinating artifacts, and led a discussion of Bowell’s life and career. The Book Club meets monthly and discusses a range of media that members have been reading and viewing.
