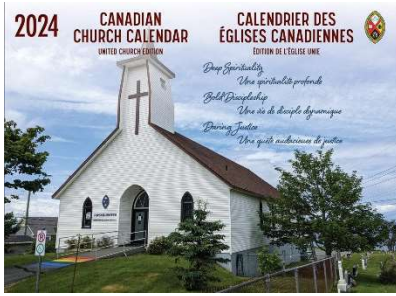
Meeting My Treaty Kin: A Journey Toward Reconciliation with Heather Menzies
