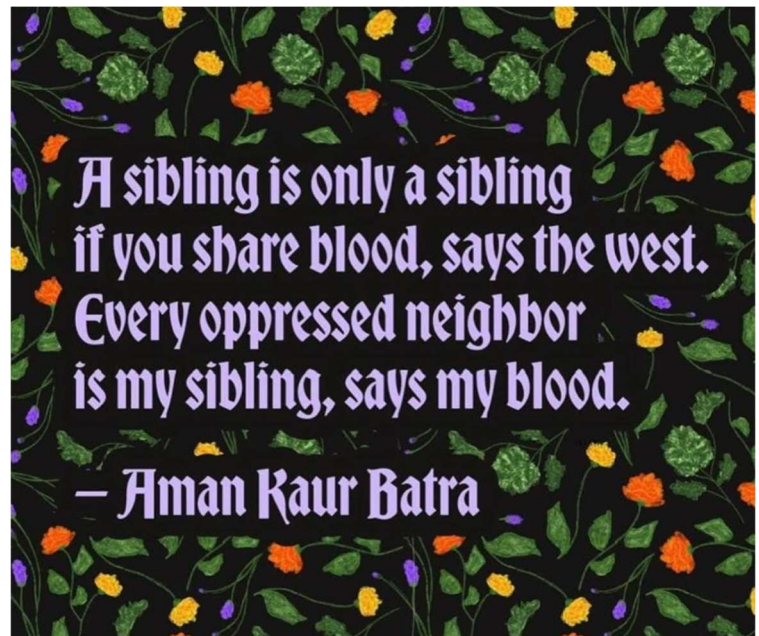
Good Afternoon,

OUTREACH- PARKDALE FOOD CENTRE/FOOD BANK

Instead of harvest fruits and vegetables, the PFC needs **personal care items, toiletries** (e.g. laundry soap, period products (tampons, pads, panty liners), adult briefs (i.e. Depends), toothpaste, razors, toothbrushes, shampoo/conditioner, body wash/soap, baby diapers, baby formula, baby food (pouches and cereal), cat litter.
