Thanks to all those who have reached out to me on the death of my sister, Elaine. I had so many messages and I appreciate each one of them. Elaine's celebration of life will be held at a later date, so family will gather again then. Again, my warm thanks.

Holy Week began on Palm Sunday. This year, I was encouraged, from a couple of places, to not include any of the Passion narrative in the Palm Sunday service. The theological reasoning was so that people could

properly experience Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem and then people are **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED** to attend both the **Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services** so that you get the whole story. Going from Palm Sunday's jubilation to Easter Sunday's jubilation leaves out the whole passion narrative, the whole account of Jesus' last meal with his disciples and then his trial, conviction and crucifixion. We must go into the depths of the story to fully appreciate the joyful news of the resurrection.

And so, you are strongly encouraged to attend both services - Maundy Thursday at 7pm (dinner at 5:30), Good Friday at 10am (lunch after at Local Heroes). Come hear the whole story!

I hope this Holy Week finds you well and I look forward to going into the depths of despair on Good Friday and celebrating with you on Easter Sunday as well. Rainbow House - Rainbow House offers safe and supportive temporary housing for 3 to 6 months. During this time, residents are supported in finding long-term housing solutions.

Must be a refugee claimant (in the process of applying for refugee status) Must identify as part of the LGBTQI+ community Must complete an intake meeting with our team

This program is designed to offer a safe and affirming space while residents transition into more permanent housing, with access to referrals and community support along the way.
