FRIDAY MESSAGE FROM DOUG BROOKS

Please note sign-up sheets will be in the hall and sign up wherever and whenever you can!

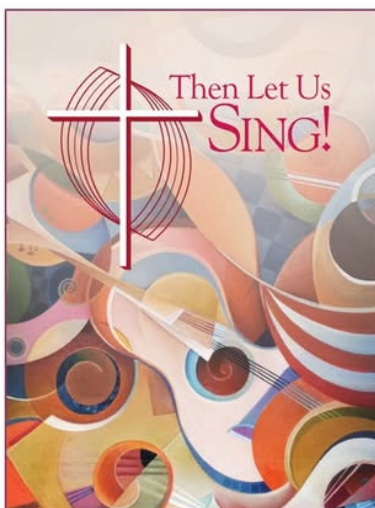
No clothes or shoes, no textbooks or magazines but your other excellent donations happily accepted.

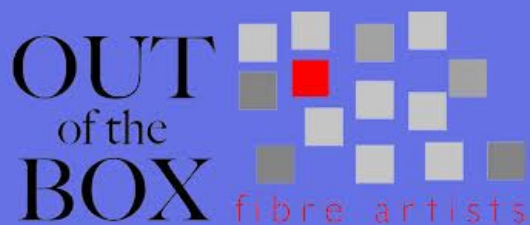
