More opportunities for learning will be coming up in Advent, so stay tuned for information about our Advent Study and a Contemplative service.


Please know that I am around if you'd like to meet with me for Pastoral care. I will have time in the next two weeks!

FRIDAY MESSAGE FROM DENISE BONOMO

My name is Denise Bonomo and I became a member of Kitchissippi United Church in 2015. It was the Syrian Refugee Crisis that prompted us to look for a church to get involved in. I have been a member of the outreach circle since then. I was a Public Health Nurse in Brockville for 34 years before I retired, married for a second time and moved to Ottawa with my husband Enrico. Once Covid restrictions were loosened and people were allowed to gather again, I worked with a small group of KUC members to ensure that we, as a church, were being health conscious and avoiding outbreaks. I have been the Chair of worship for about 5 years and enjoy working with the good members of the worship circles to bring learnings and praise to God each week. If you are interested in joining this group, you would be most welcome.

In 2023 I was asked to become the KUC Chair of Council. After discussions with Enrico, I said I would accept the nomination. My term of service will end at the next Annual Meeting in April 2026. Laurie Joe, our current Vice-chair, will be replacing me, freeing me up to find other ways to serve.

Since the summer Rev Jenni has been away from the church often and I have tried to "fill in" on some of her many jobs. I am VERY glad that she is returning to full-time work soon.

I have really enjoyed meeting the many Gods' Beloved members and especially Rev. Daniel. I love Rev. Daniel because I can see myself in him. We both like big dreams, know God is present in our lives, and almost never say "No". He wrote me the most beautiful poem for my birthday called "And she said Yes." It touched my heart and has been put with my funeral plans so it can be shared one more time when I have passed on.

The new God's Beloved will not know that my husband Enrico passed away on August 11, 2024, the same day the God's Beloved ministry started at Kitchissippi UC. He was a very smart, funny, brave, kind man, but his body was mis-formed from birth, and his speech was not very clear. I spent a lot of time helping him with activities he could not do alone. Travelling to interesting places in the world

was one of our great passions. I miss him. I am grateful that in my mourning Kitchissippi was a refuge and a place for me to offer care to others. My first husband Dennis, who died back in 2005, always said I had an overactive helper gene. He knew me so well!




Black History Ottawa Tour – Discover the Trailblazers Who Broke Barriers

BEHIND THE SCENES: BE PART OF MAGIC!!! ARE YOU CURIOUS AND WANT TO KNOW MORE???


Have you ever wondered what goes on up in the balcony every Sunday; what all that equipment is and how it works? What goes on behind the scenes before Sunday? Want to learn more?

Winter is coming! If you or someone you know needs warm clothing for children, the Snowsuit Fund Depot is now offering new children's snowsuits for families in need across Ottawa. Families can schedule an appointment online or call 613-746-8719 to book a pickup time.

- O Please note: walk-ins are not accepted.
- Location:

225 Donald Street, Unit 134 (back of the building, red door)

- Program details:
 - Only one family member or delegate should attend the appointment.
 - Snowsuits are available for children ages 0–15 years.
 - To be eligible, families must be low income or receiving social assistance.
- Documents required at pickup:
 - Proof of child(ren)'s date of birth (e.g., birth certificate, permanent resident card)
 - Proof of residence in Ottawa (e.g., lease or utility bill)
 - Proof of income (e.g., Ontario Works statement, child tax benefit, GST notice, RAP form, or drug card/start-up allowance)
